## Due to popular demand, Geva extends run of ***MILLION DOLLAR QUARTET*** through July 2nd

Rochester, N.Y., May 24, 2017 – Geva Theatre Center announces that, due to popular demand, ***Million Dollar Quartet*** will be extended through July 2<sup>nd</sup>. To date, the first week of performances is 95% sold out and many subsequent shows are sold out or close to selling out. *Million Dollar Quartet*, with book by Floyd Mutrux and Colin Escott, is based on an original concept by Floyd Mutrux and inspired by the music of Elvis Presley, Johnny Cash, Jerry Lee Lewis and Carl Perkins. *Million Dollar Quartet* is directed by Hunter Foster and will be performed in the Elaine P. Wilson Stage from **May 30 to July 2**.

On December 4, 1956, four young musicians got together at Sun Records in Memphis for what would become one of the greatest jam sessions ever. Put on your blue suede shoes and join Jerry Lee Lewis, Elvis Presley, Johnny Cash and Carl Perkins for the recording session of a lifetime. Loaded with classic rock 'n roll hits such as "Great Balls of Fire," "Sixteen Tons," "I Walk the Line," "Hound Dog" and many more.

The cast of *Million Dollar Quartet* features **Alyssa Gardner** as Dyanne, **Taylor Gray** as Jerry Lee Lewis, **Josh Kerr** as Brother Jay, **Dan Leali** as Fluke; **James Ludwig** as Sam Phillips; **John Michael Presney** as Carl Perkins; **Trent Rowland** as Elvis Presley and **Sky Seals** as Johnny Cash. **Hunter Foster** makes his directing debut at Geva with *Million Dollar Quartet*.
